Another summer has ended with five youth camps in Germany. It's amazing, but God touches young people way above our expectations. Each summer I think, it can't really get much better than this, and then God surprises us with a fresh move of His Spirit.



Not all campers come to meet God; some are there because their friends invited them and/or they want to improve their English. Read what one camper wrote in the beginning of a camp:  
*I don't think that God is real. It's not normal to believe on something we can't see. However, I like to sing Christian songs with the others and it is fun. Perhaps Jesus or God will show Himself to me that they really exist. I hope so.*



Toward the end of the camp, the same person wrote in their journal:  
*My favorite experience was that God touched me during worship. Some of the others cried*

*during that time, and even I had tears in my eyes. I was so happy! It was as if someone had given me a million Euro. I even talked to God, and we're having a relationship now!*

Testimonies like these are common and are a result of your prayers for these camps. As in the past, some churches have sent people to these camps. A Presbyterian church from Lancaster, PA sent a team and their support was a tremendous help. Our friends from Paraguay also came again to serve on staff.

Short-term mission trips bless not only the German teens, but they will bless you. Why not pray about whether you—or even better, your church—will send a team next summer!

## CHANGE OF AFFILIATION

As in many things, change is a fact of life. For quite a few years, we have been under the umbrella of Janz-Team Canada. Recently their mission statement has changed, so that now their prime purpose is to send out teachers. Even though such outreach is important, it is not what we are doing! For that reason, we have formed our own non-profit organization, "God's Fire Ministries". ## UPCOMING TRIP TO INDIA AND NEPAL

On September 14, I will be traveling to India and Nepal. For security reasons we are not listing the exact places on the website, however, we will give you more details in our letters addressed to you personally.

The first part of the trip will be in northern India and Nepal. Trip expenses will cost us around \$6000. That includes plane fares, feeding the people, support for pastors and

paying for all other expenses, such as meetings, traveling, etc. Of course, it is understood that we need financial support for this trip, but we also want to point out that we do not want to use manipulative methods to receive support. Our experience has been—and that may not be the experience of other ministries—that God has spoken to people on an individual basis and that we want to continue to trust God for finances.



What are some of the spiritual expectations? One pastor organizer wrote us, “About 75% of the attendees are not Christians but Hindus; however, they all expect signs and miracles to follow the ministry.”

We will also minister to the Bhutanese people. Hidden deep in the Himalayan Mountains, Bhutan is a small kingdom located between China and India. It is one of the least evangelized nations in the world, as evangelism is strictly prohibited there. Only 0.46% are Christians.



Several generations ago, many Nepali moved to Bhutan. In the early 1990’s, they became the target of “ethnic cleansing” and their Bhutanese citizenship was forcefully revoked. Over 100,000 ethnically Nepalese people fled Bhutan and settled in seven refugee camps in Nepal. Quite a few of these have settled in the U.S. and other western countries.

For our meetings, many Bhutanese will cross the border to India for our meetings. Other meetings are scheduled in eastern Nepal.
